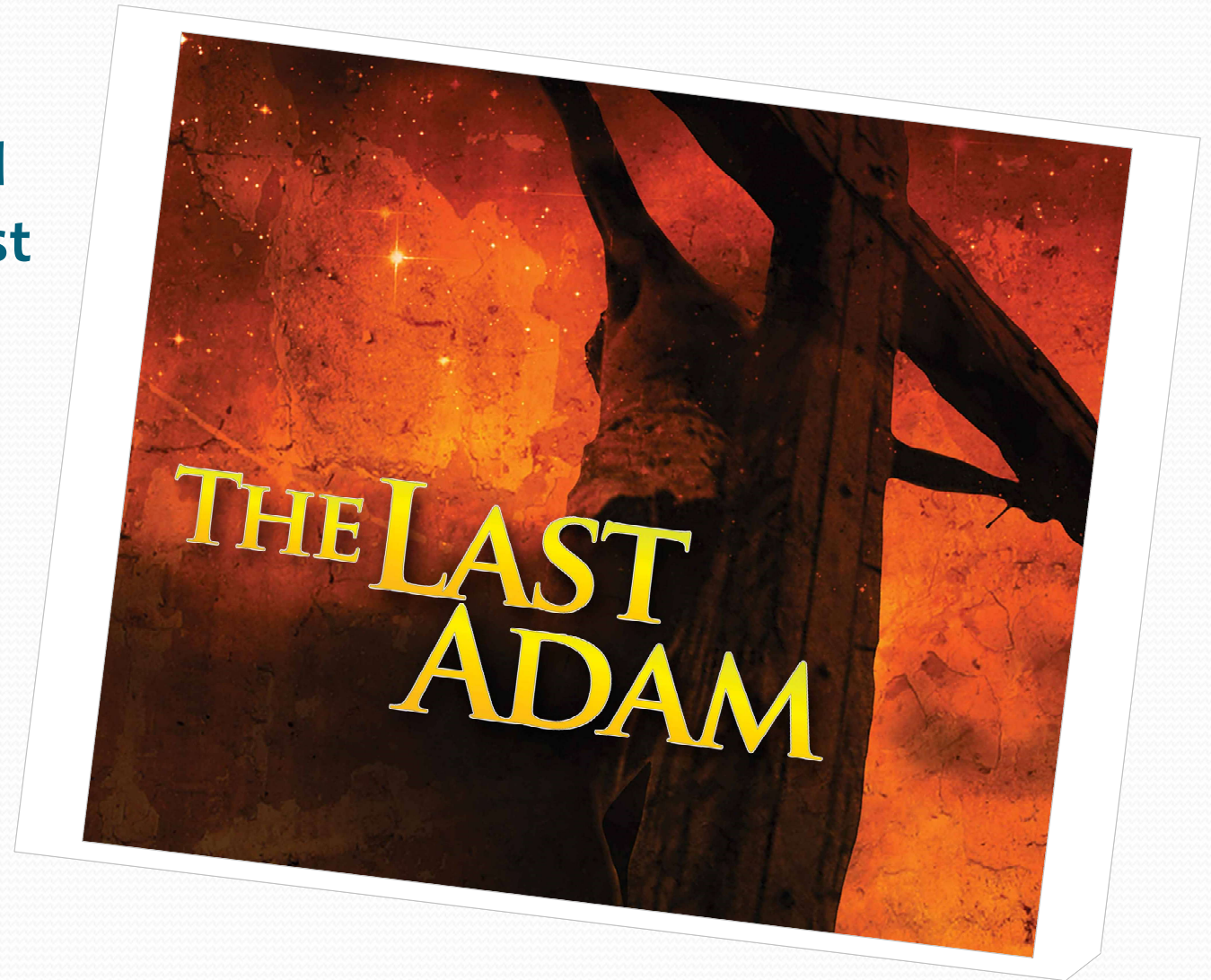

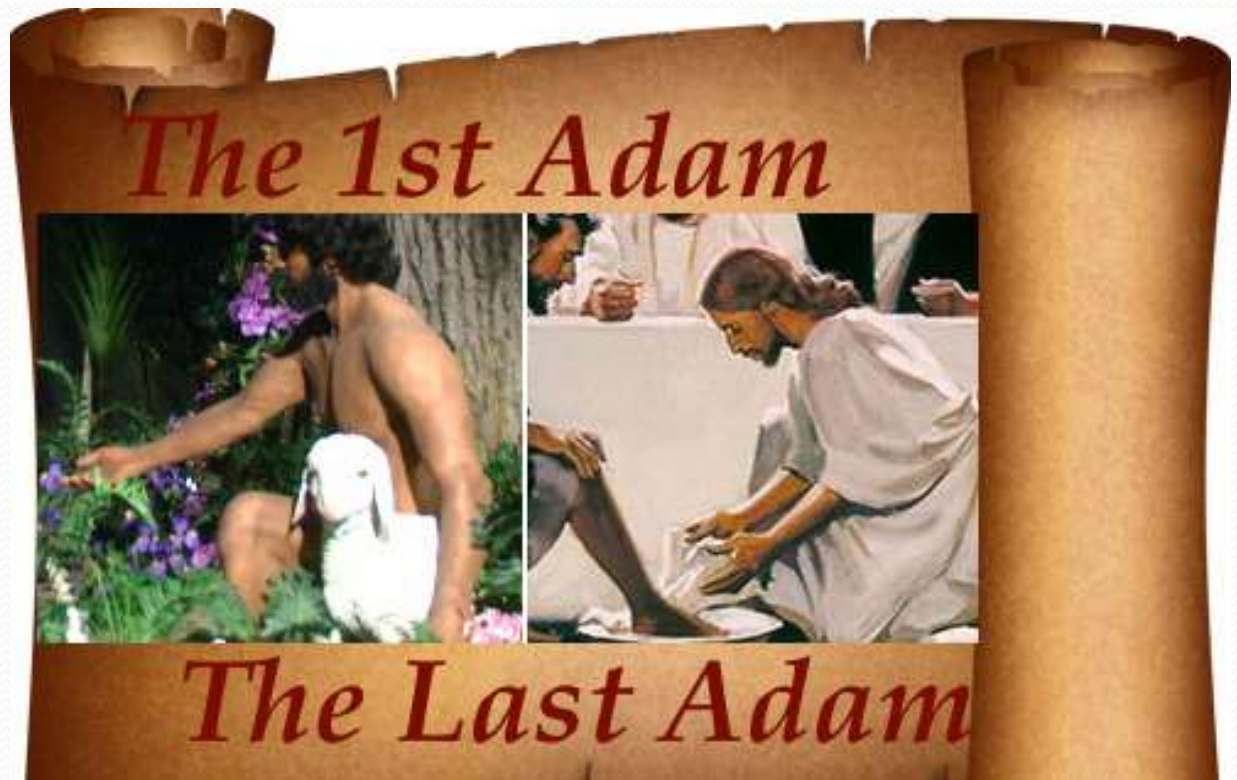


"The First Adam"

TWO GARDENS (1)

1. The one in Eden was full of life before the Fall. The one in Gethsemane was over the Brook Kidron: “When Jesus had spoken these words, He went out with His disciples over the Brook Kidron, where there was a garden” *John 18:1*



TWO GARDENS (2)

- “And the whole valley of the dead bodies and of the ashes, and all the fields as far as the Brook Kidron, to the corner of the Horse Gate toward the east, *shall be holy to the LORD*”

Jeremiah 31:40



TWO GARDENS (3)

2. The First Adam satisfied his own will there. The Last Adam submitted His will entirely to the Father: “Father, if it is Your will, take this cup away from Me; nevertheless not My will, but Yours, be done.” *Luke 22:42*

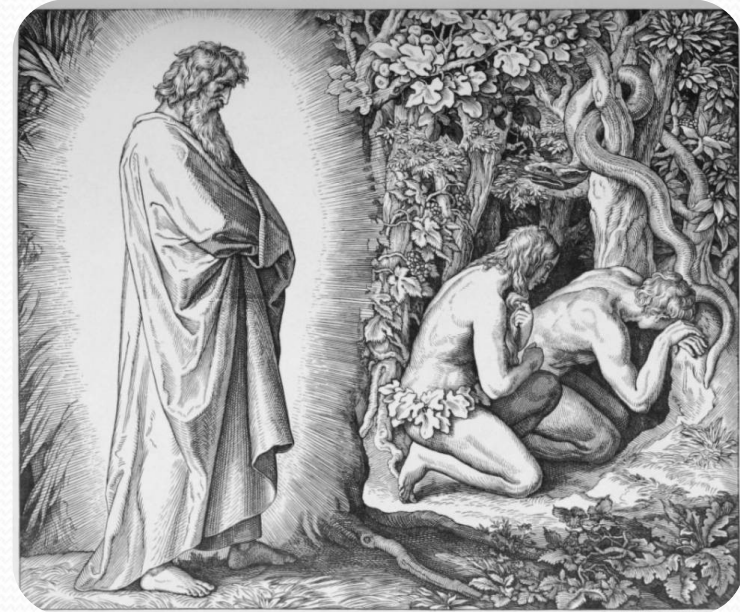


TWO GARDENS (4)

3. “Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God among the trees of the garden”

Genesis 3:8

- “Jesus therefore, knowing all things that would come upon Him, went forward and said to them, ‘Whom are you seeking?’” *John 18:4*



TWO GARDENS (5)

4. The first Adam sought after his selfish gains so he died along with all of his children.

- The Last Adam thought of others to save them and set them free:

“Jesus answered, ‘I have told you that I am He. Therefore, if you seek Me, let these go their way’” *John 18:8*



TWO GARDENS (6)

5. Because of his transgression, Adam was sent out of the garden. Because of the sacrifice of the Last Adam, paradise was open to the first Adam and his children.



TWO TREES ⁽¹⁾

1. The serpent seduced the First Adam and defeated him at the tree of knowing good and evil. The Last Adam crushed the serpent's head at the Tree of the Cross.



TWO TREES (2)

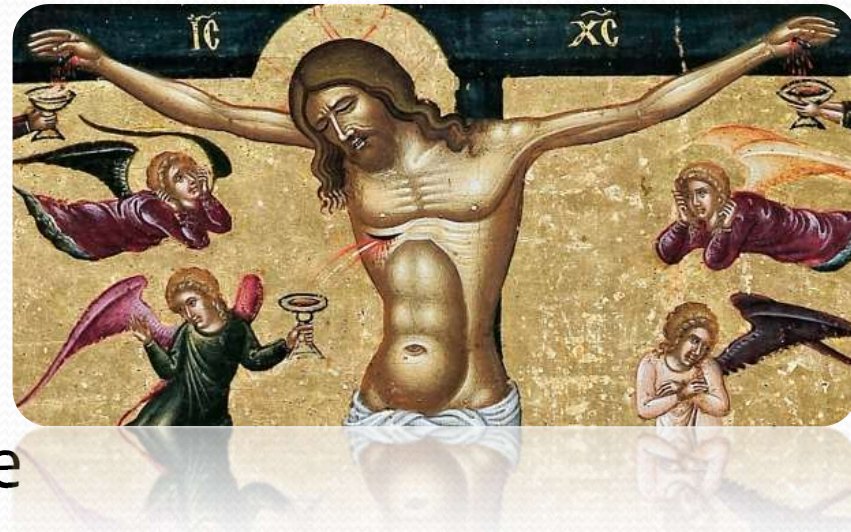
2. The First Adam was stripped of grace and became naked. The Last Adam “ascended upon the Cross naked that He might clothe us with the garment of His righteousness”

TWO TREES (3)

3. At the tree, Adam was separated from God and from everyone else. At the Cross, the Lord Christ's side was opened with a spear from which water and blood flowed to unite everyone to Himself and to the Father.



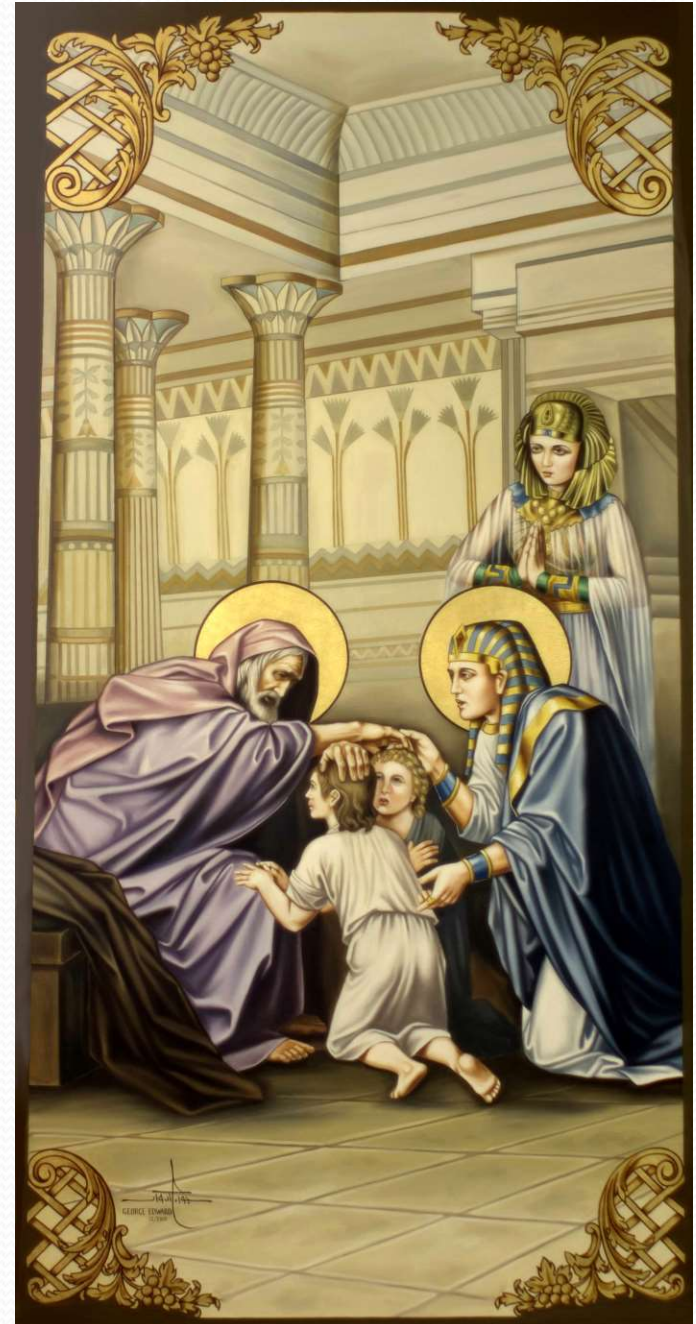
TWO TREES (4)

4. At the tree, Adam was given a fruit to eat and die. On the Cross, the Last Adam gave Himself as Food from above that became the medicine of immortality.



TWO TREES (5)

5. It's the Cross that transferred the Birthright from the First Adam to be laid on the Head of the Last Adam.



TWO ADAMS (1)

1. “The first man was of the earth, made of dust; the second Man is the Lord from heaven”

1 Cor. 15:47

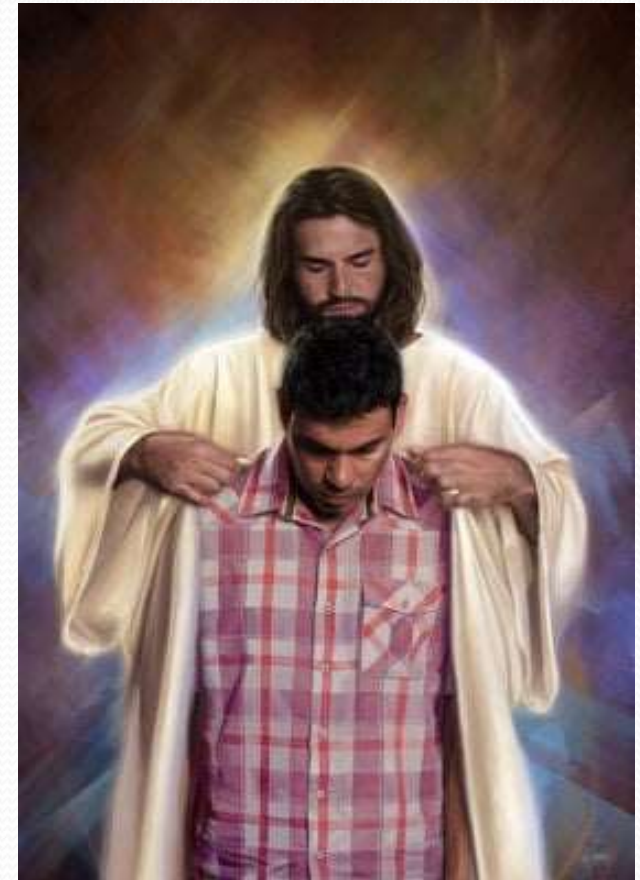
2. “The first man Adam became a living being. The last Adam *became* a life-giving spirit” 1 Cor. 15:45



TWO ADAMS (2)

3. “Therefore, as through one man’s offense *judgment came* to all men, resulting in condemnation, even so through one Man’s righteous act *the free gift came* to all men, resulting in justification of life”

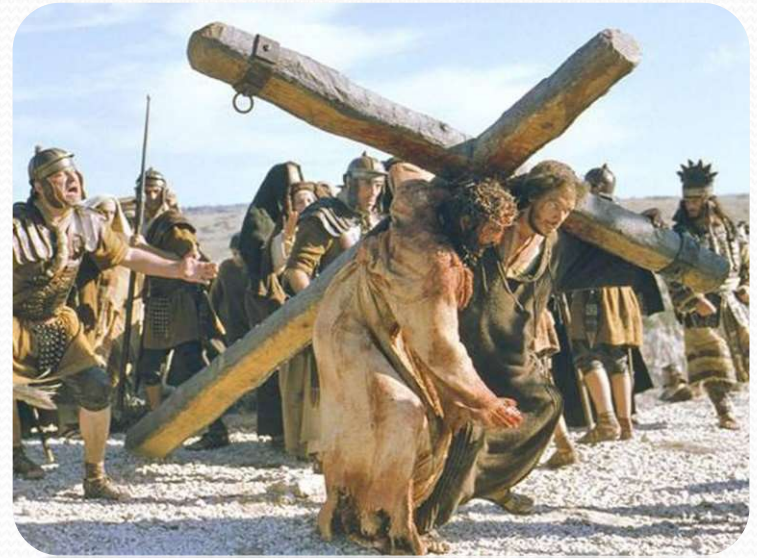

TWO ADAMS (3)

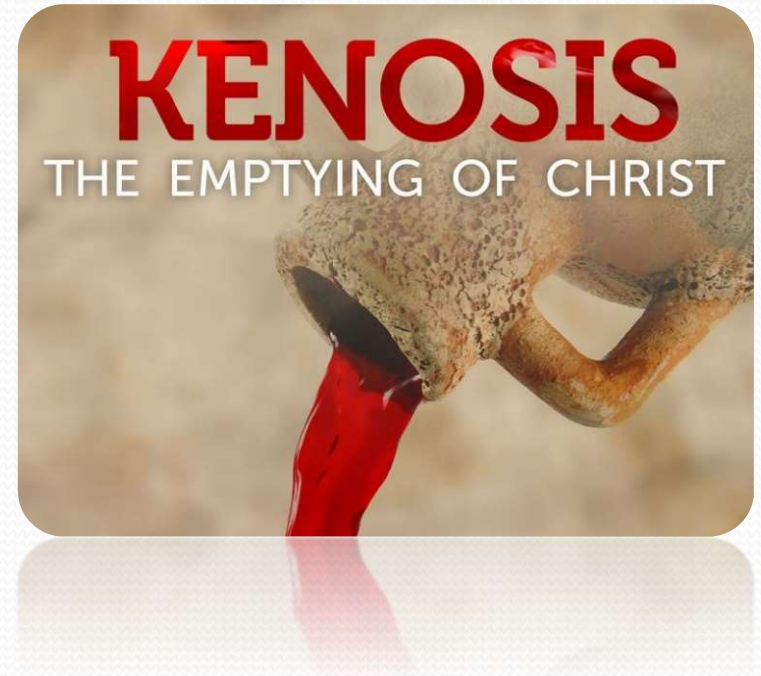
4. “For as by one man’s disobedience many were made sinners, so also by one Man’s obedience many will be made righteous.”

Romans 5:19



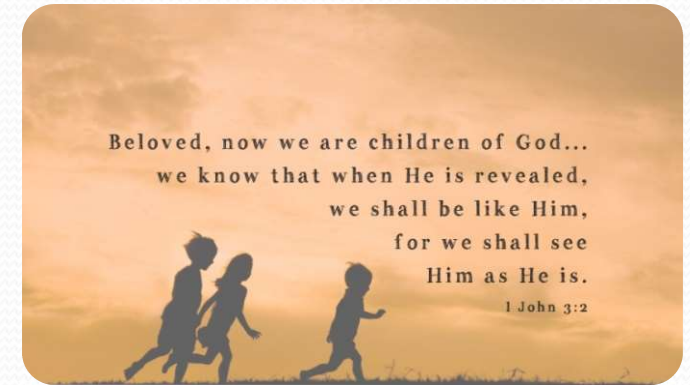
TWO ADAMS (4)

5. In his pride, the First Adam wanted to be like God. In His humility, the Last Adam emptied himself from Glory and became the Son of Man so that we might be Children of God



TWO ADAMS (5)

6. Even though we are born of the First Adam, “But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name: who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God” *John 1: 12 – 13*



TWO ADAMS (6)

- For His redemption, and on this promise, we dare to call God, Abba Father: “Do not call anyone on earth your father; for One is your Father, He who is in heaven” *Matthew 23:9*
