

I. DIFFERENT CALLINGS (1)

1. <u>Salt:</u>


- ✓ Gives Flavor to the food
- ✓ Preserve it from decay
- ✓ Cheap yet indispensable



I. DIFFERENT CALLINGS (2)

2. <u>Light:</u>

- ✓ Guides through the sanctified life and the knowledge of the Truth (God from the beginning chose you for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and belief in the truth"
 - 2 Thessalonians 2:13
- ✓ Comforts and spreads joy



I. DIFFERENT CALLINGS (3)


3. Ambassadors:

✓ "Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God"

2 Corinthians 5:20

- ✓ Represents the One who sent Him.
- ✓ Carries a message of peace





I. DIFFERENT CALLINGS (5)

5. Priests:

- ✓ "Therefore, I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men" 1 Timothy 2:1
- ✓ Consecrated to the service of God
- ✓ Offering the sacrifices of praise and glorification daily
- ✓ Teaching and exhorting one another





II. IN COMMON (1)

- Each calling is a blessing and a responsibility.
- 2. The life fitting the calling "I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you to walk worthy of the calling with which you were called, with all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love, endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace"






II. IN COMMON (2)

- The Calling can be only carried out by partaking of what is for Christ through a real fellowship with Him and sharing it with others.
- 4. Losing the Calling makes us of no worth
 "You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt
 loses its flavor, how shall it be seasoned? It is
 then good for nothing but to be thrown out
 and trampled underfoot by men"

Matthew 5:13





III. LOSING FLAVOR

- Not realizing the Calling. Life is lost in selfish ambitions or wasteful consumption.
- 2. Disconnected from the One who called or from the Church that renew the life in us.
- 3. The dual life and trying to keep light and darkness in the same place "For what fellowship has righteousness with lawlessness? And what communion has light with darkness? And what accord has Christ with Belial? Or what part has a believer with an unbeliever?" 2 Corinthians 6: 14 15
- 4. Being enslaved to the passions of the evil one or the love of the passing world.
