**How does the Holy Spirit
teach us the virtue of
“Discernment”?**

1. He is all knowledge, yet He teaches what He hears from the Father

2. He is One in essence with the Father and the Son, yet His mission is to glorify the Son

“He will glorify Me, for He will take of what is Mine and declare it to you”
