
I. The Conscience (1)

- It is the compass that points to what is good and convicts us regarding what is evil
- “Then those who heard it, being convicted by their conscience, went out one by one” *John 8:9*



I. The Conscience (2)

- The tool of the conscience needs to be cleared and trained to maintain its saving function.
- “I myself always strive to have a conscience without offense toward God and men” *Acts 24:16*

the Conscience




II. The Spirit of God (1)

- “And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment”

John 16:8

- The Holy Spirit convicts, yet He is the Helper who guides, corrects, comforts, and supports our weakness



II. The Spirit of God (2)

- His voice ought to be obeyed lest we grieve and quench Him in us:
“And do not grieve the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption”

III. The righteousness of others (1)



- St. Augustine's conversion after reading the story of St. Anthony




IV. Spiritual guides and leaders (1)

- Nathan the prophet and King David



IV. Spiritual guides and leaders (2)

- Jonah and the people of Nineveh
- Being blinded by an inflated ego
will make this tool of no benefit to
those stricken with pride and self-righteousness



V. The Law of God (1)



- “...but if you show partiality, you commit sin, and are convicted by the law as transgressors”

- At the time of Nehemiah:
“For all the people wept, when they heard the words of the Law”

Nehemiah 8:9




V. The Law of God (2)
