


## The motives to love an enemy (1)

1. This is one of the marks of the resurrection in our lives:


"We know that we have passed from death to life, because we love the

those who love them" Luke 6:32




#### The motives to love an enemy (4)

  Forgive, and you will be forgiven" Luke 6:37



Love is granted when we decide to pray for those who hate us




#### How to love an enemy? (3)
