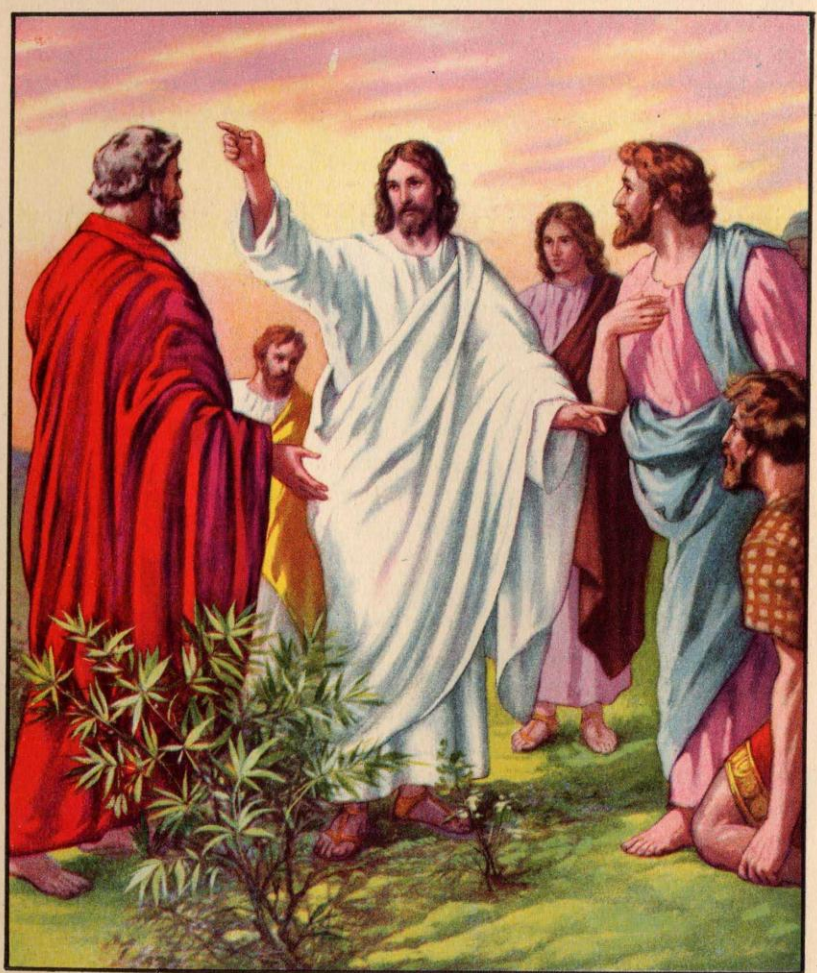


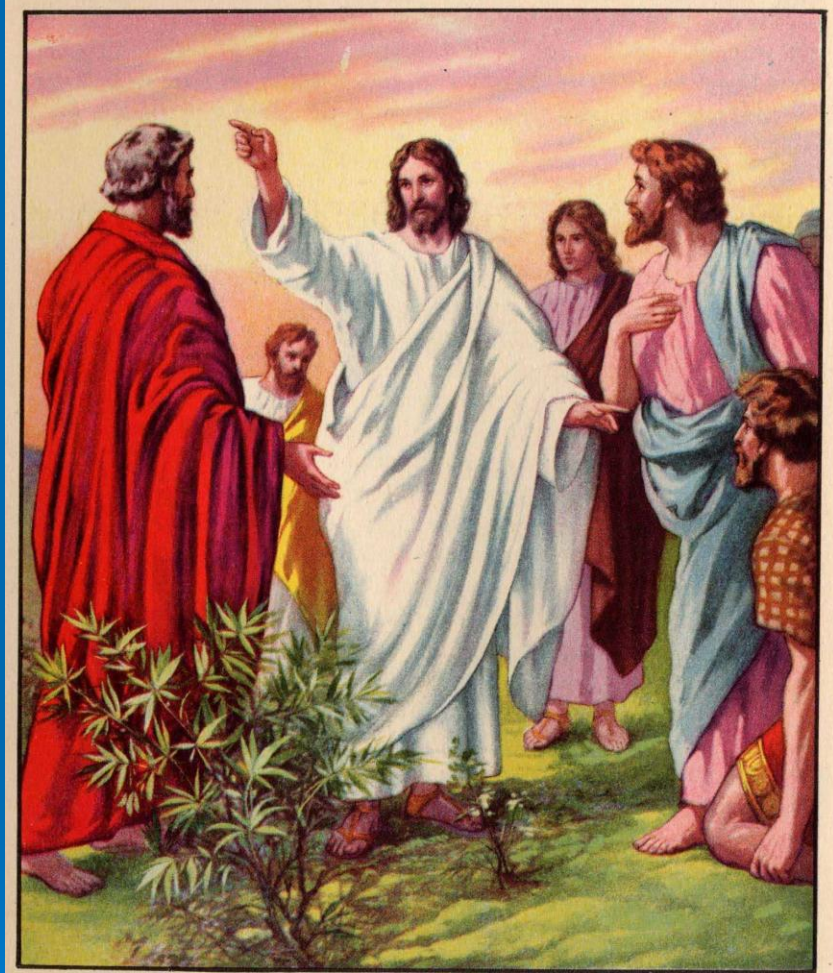

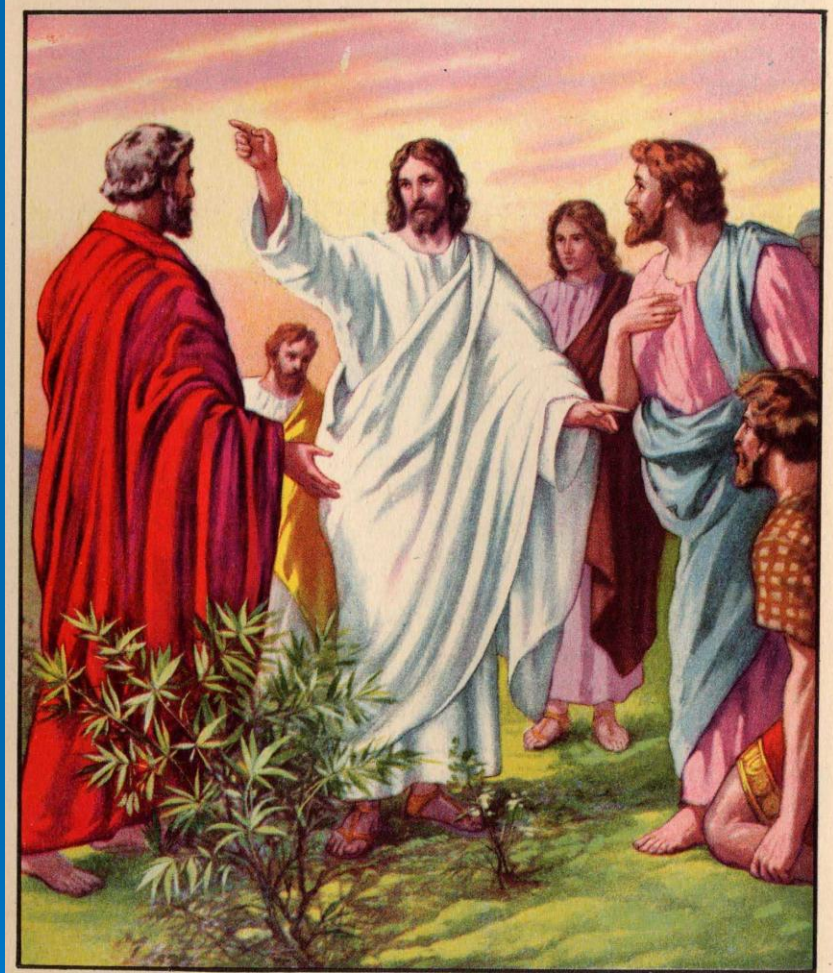


**1. They were appointed and sent by Him. He takes good care of those who serve Him.**

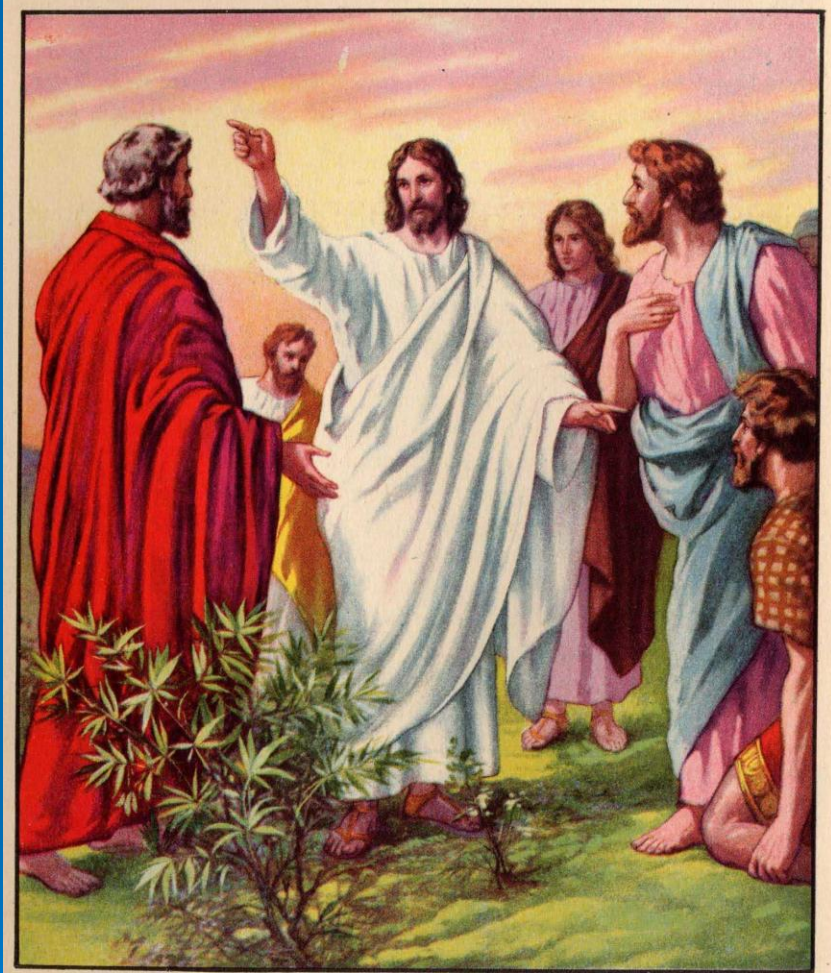

mission.**

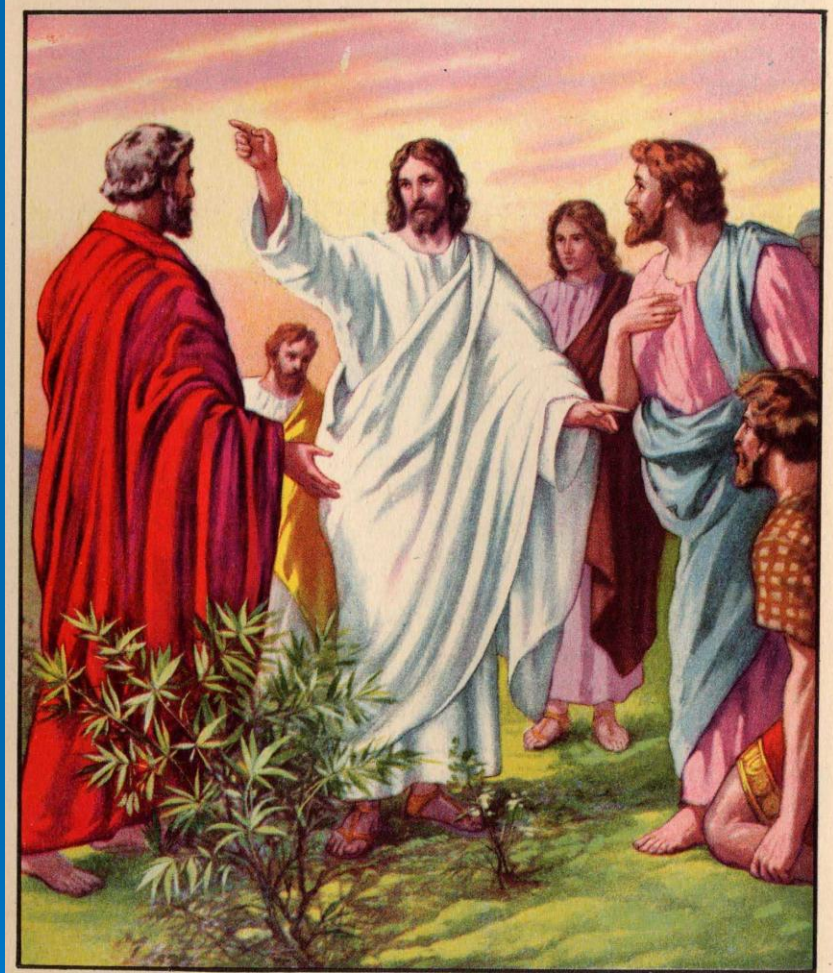


**3. They spoke

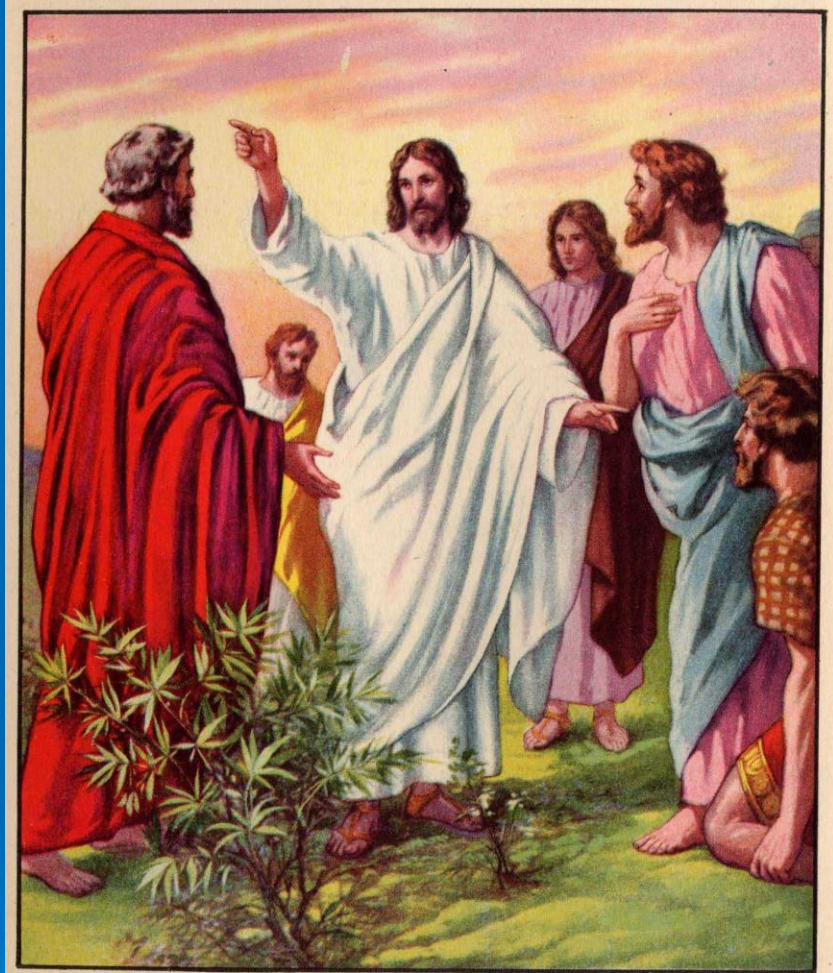

**4. He gave them authority over demons even though they were sent as lambs among wolves.**

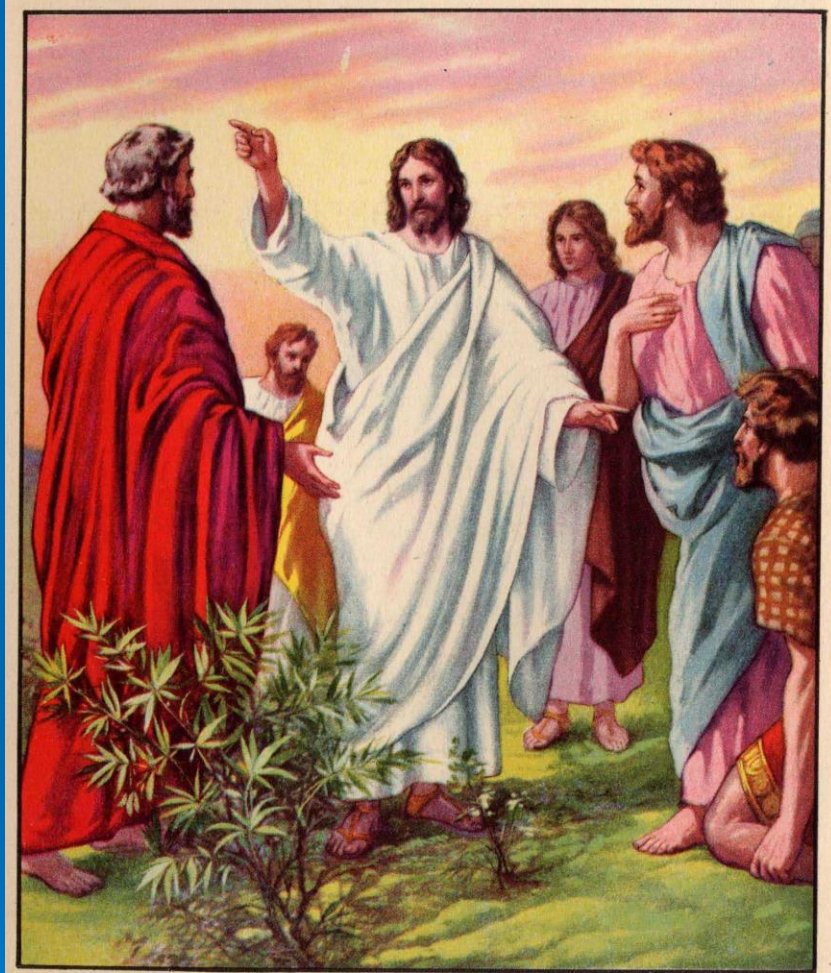


**5. He gave them
