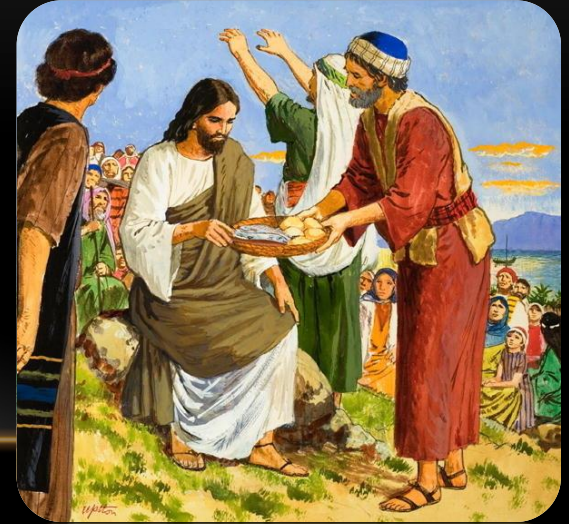

4. Willing to sacrifice to save others

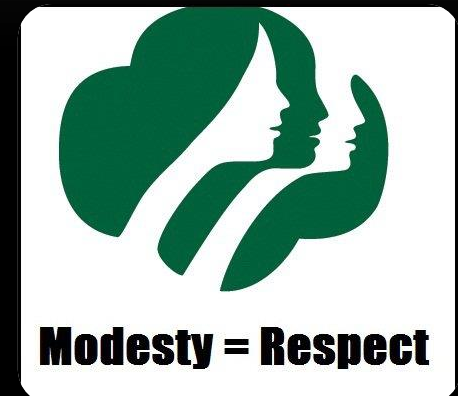
- Esther
