Introduction

- The Lord Christ often spoke of the Kingdom of Heaven
 - “The kingdom of heaven is like a man who sowed good seed in his field...” (Matt. 13:24)
 - “The kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed...” (Matt. 13:31)
 - “The kingdom of heaven is like leaven...” (Matt. 13:33)
 - “the kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field...” (Matt. 13:44)
 - “the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant seeking beautiful pearls...” (Matt. 13:45)
 - “the kingdom of heaven is like a dragnet...” (Matt. 13:47)

Casting out a demon and the Kingdom of Heaven

- Matt. 12:29 – “Or how can one enter a strong man's house and plunder his goods, unless he first binds the strong man? And then he will plunder his house.”



The Kingdom of Heaven and the Kingdom of God

 - “I go to prepare a place for you. 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also.” (Jn. 14:2-3)

 - “The kingdom of God is within you.” (Lk. 17:20-21)

The Kingdom of God is a breaking through
