the rich young ruler?**

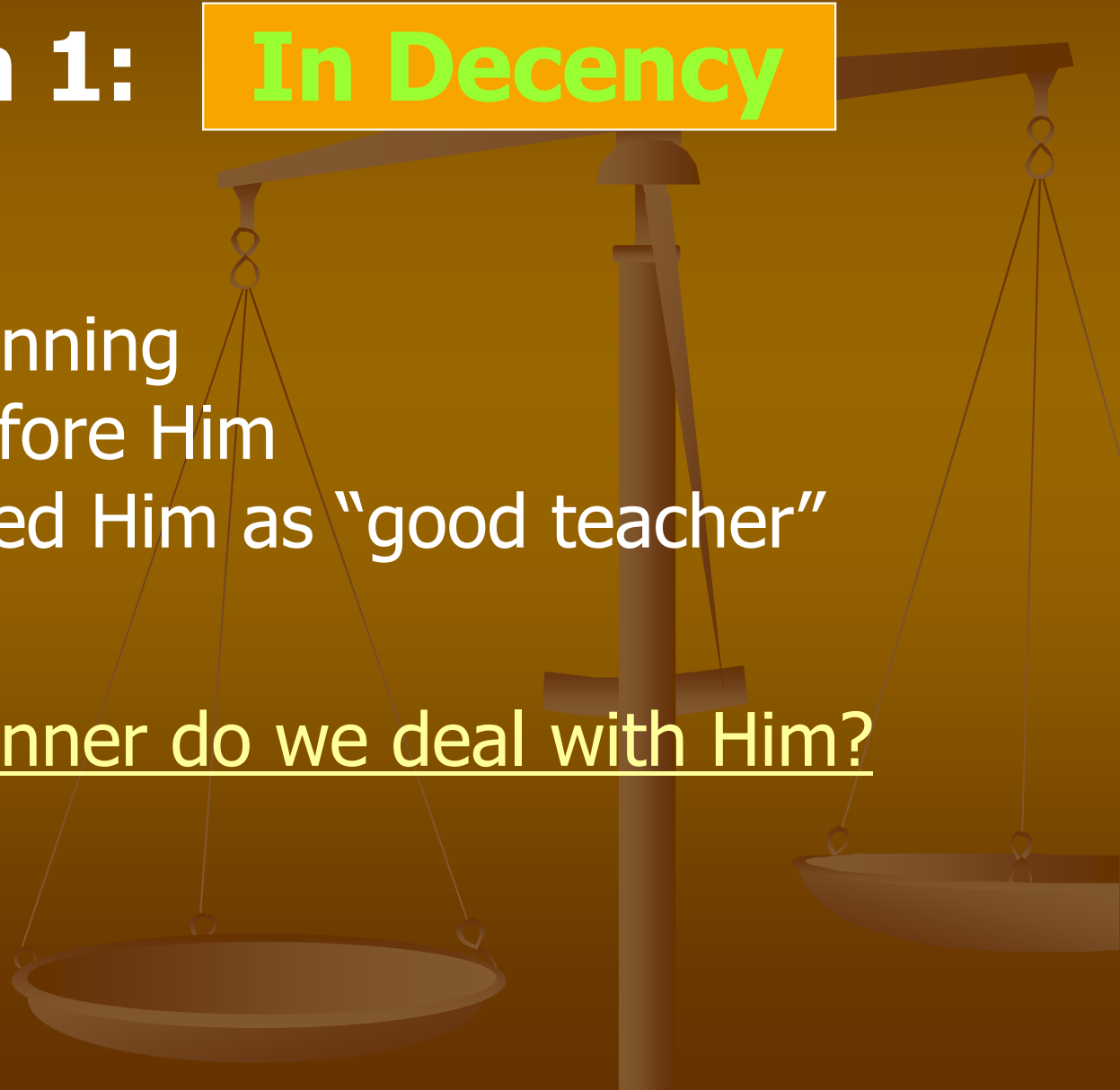


Question 1:

In which manner do we deal with Him?

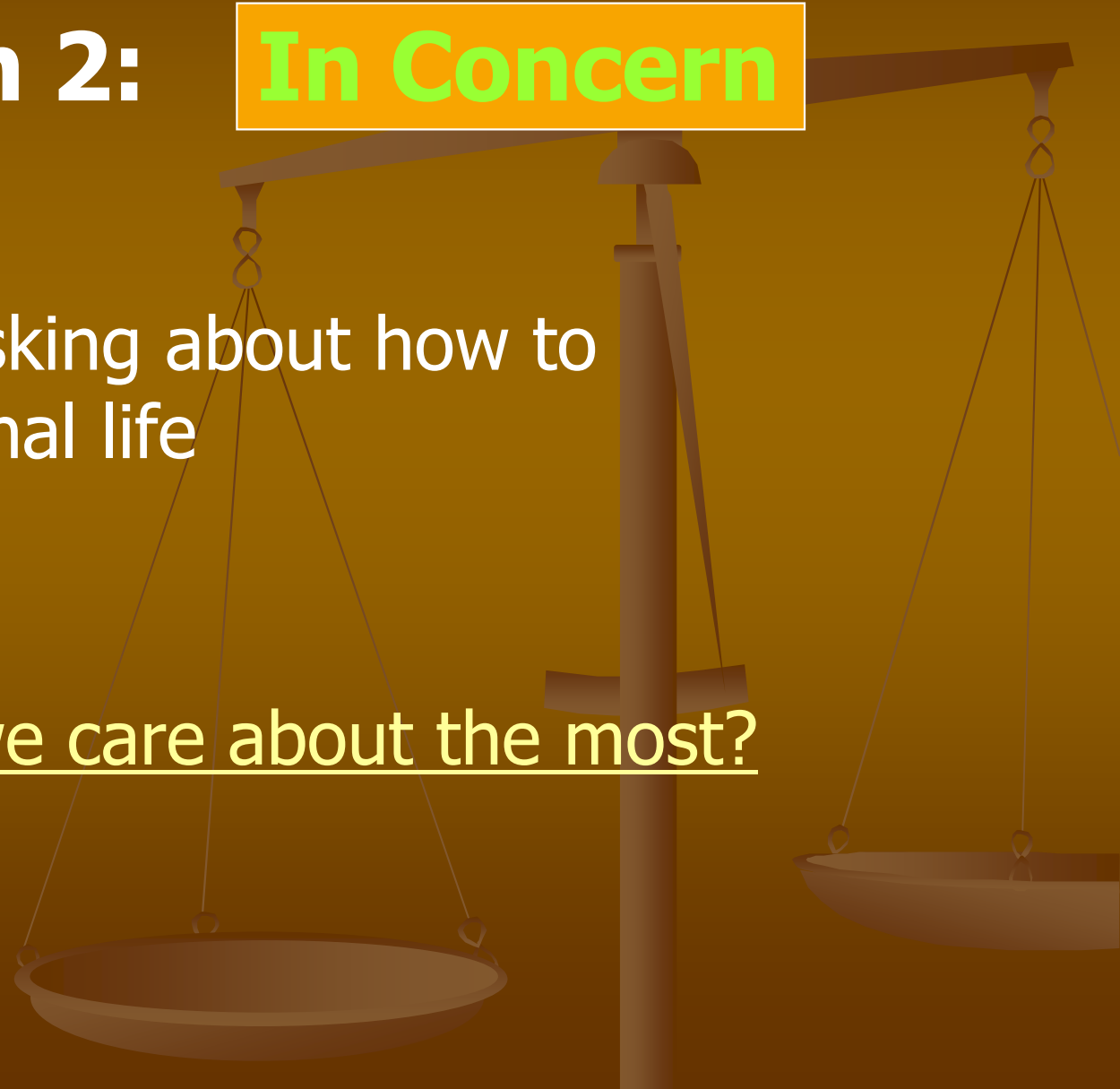


Question 2:

What do we care about the most?

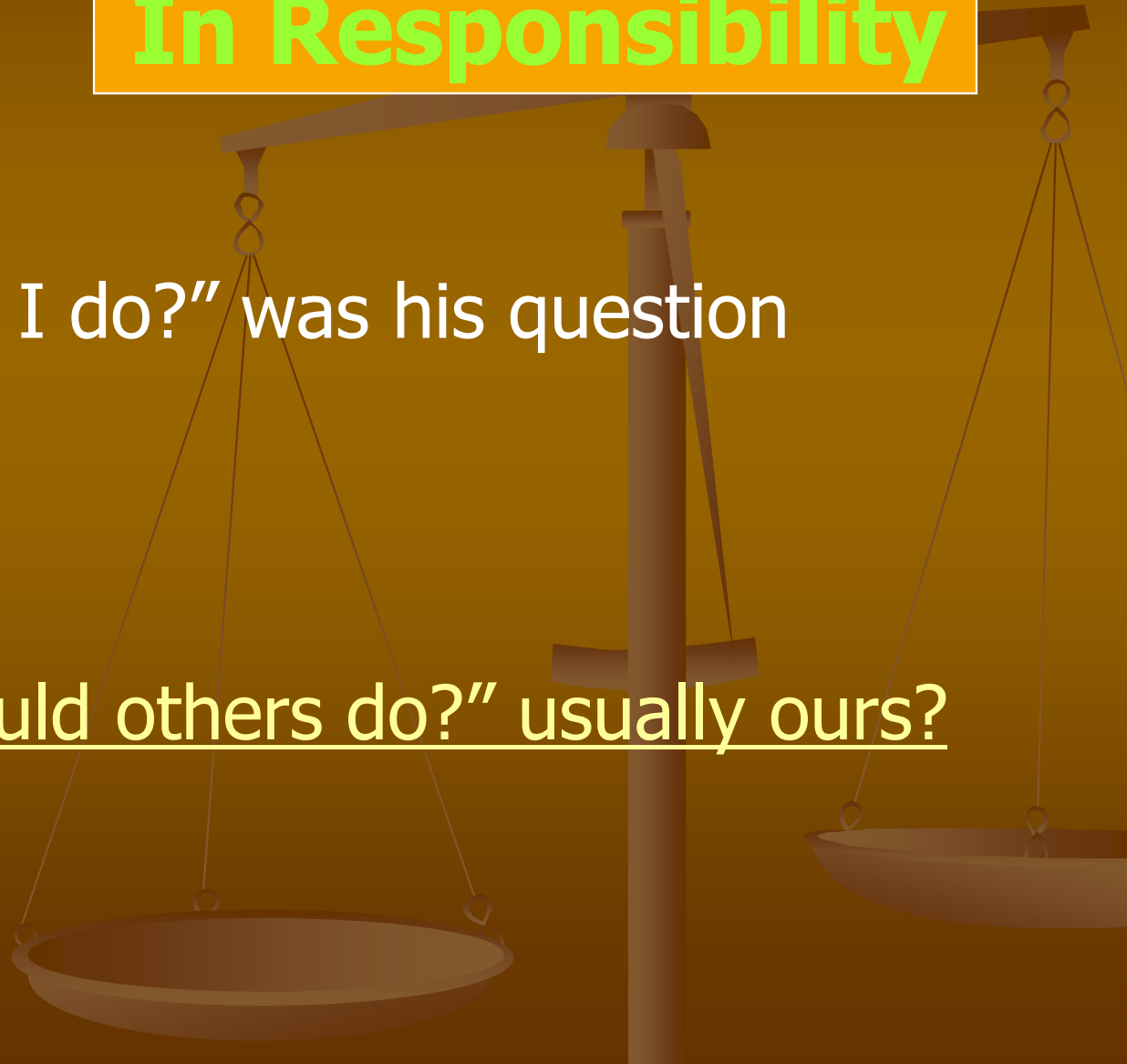


Question 3:

Isn't "What should others do?" usually ours?

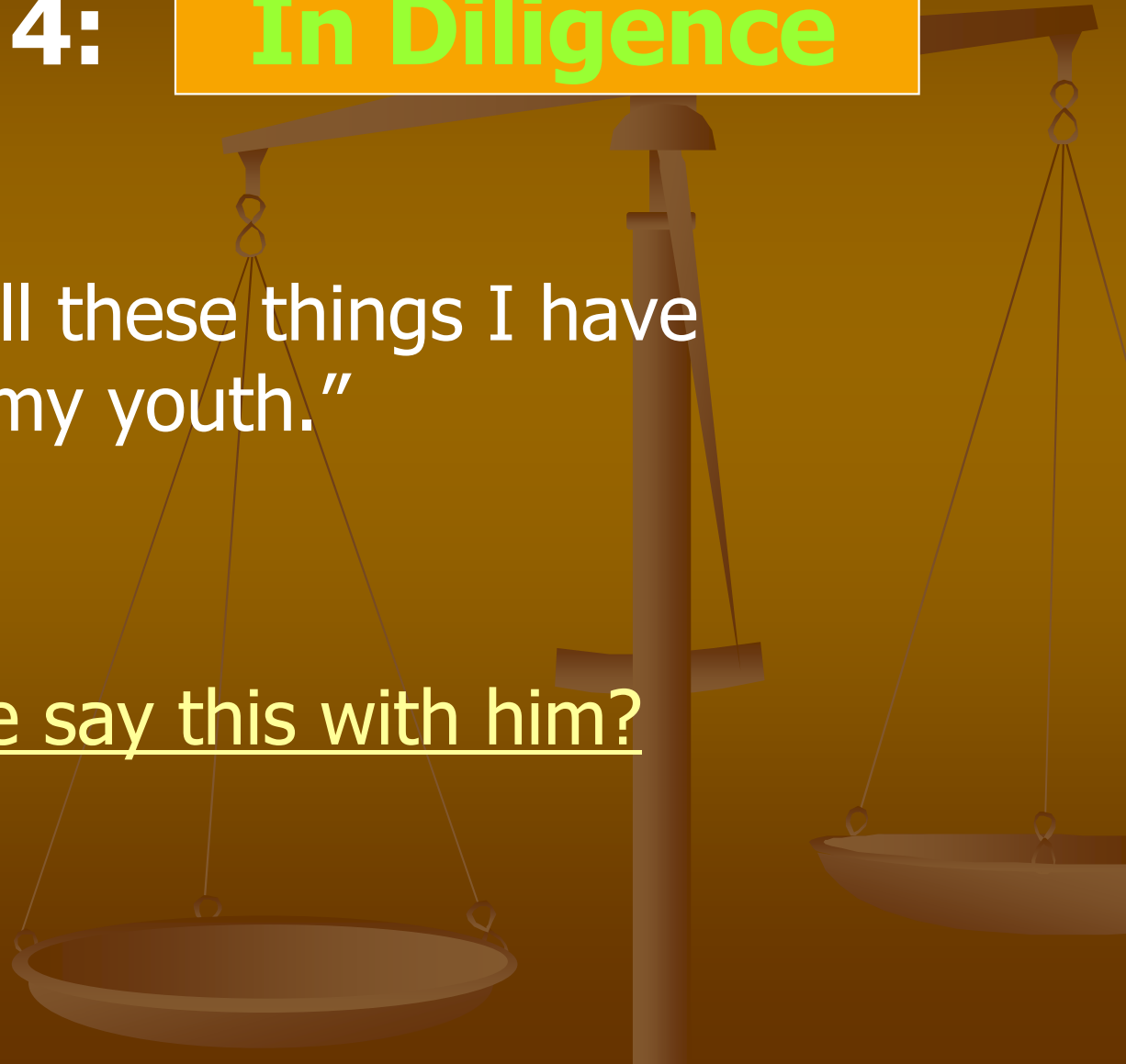


Question 4:
