



Visitation



➤ Visitation is the most important activity in our service.

- We are not school teachers
 - Service is life
 - It is a relationship between the servant and the student
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➤ The importance of the individual visit

- Jesus did this with:
 - The Samaritan Woman
 - Zacchaeus
 - The Pharisee
 - Lazarus with Mariam and Martha



- I will not have any effect on anyone unless I have a relationship with him/her
- Everyone is different. So we need to deal with each one individually. This will be done through visitation



Before the visitation

1. Pray
 2. Think about their need
 - a) Review his/her character, behavior
 - b) Be prepared for any expected question or issue
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During the visit

1. Give the student all the attention
 2. Be on his side and do not rebuke him for any complain
 3. Be prepared with some positive points about him
 - For defending against parents' accusations, if required
 4. Start with a social conversation with him/her according to the age. (Home, friends, studies, tests, work....)
 - Make it a friendly conversation, not question and answer.
 5. Talk about the spiritual life
 6. Conclude your visit:
 - For young ages with short prayer.
 - For old ages by reading few verses and prayer.
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- **Overall make your visit as short as you can.**



Workshop: Speed Visitation

1. Within each class, divide into groups of 2
 - 1 person will be the servants
 - The other will be the student (act the age group)
 2. You'll have 8 minutes to "visit"
 - Treat this as a "real" visitation
 3. At the signal, you'll move on to the next group and switch roles (student becomes servant, servant becomes student)
 4. Repeat...
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
