
• Fasting and our return to the Kingdom of God

- Adam is given dominion over the Creation and honored by it.






THE GARDEN (2)

observe: Submission to God's


Lordship.


THE FALL (1)

Breaking God's Law and getting broken by it.

- The Fear and Anxiety.
- The loss of control and the humiliation:
 - √ The Prodigal Son
 - √ The People of Israel







THE RETURN (1)

- The incarnation of the Son of God and the restoration of the Kingdom "From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand." *Matthew 4:17*
- If "Thy Kingdom Come", then "Thy will be done"



THE RETURN (2)

- The restoration:
 - ✓ Fasting: Control over my self
 - ✓ Prayers: Delighting and finding comfort in God again
 - ✓ Charity: The compassion toward my brother and sister



THE RETURN (3)

- With the restoring triad comes an essential change in mindset:
 - Breaking God's command and losing my freedom, joy, and sense of purpose.
 - 2. I only fool myself when I look for shortcuts



THE RETURN (4)

- 3. With Fasting, prayers, and charity there should be a change in heart and abandonment of the evil doings and the works of darkness.
- 4. God's command is for my own benefit. "They shall be My people, and I will be their God; then I will give them one heart and one way, that they may fear Me forever, for the good of them and their children after them" Jeremiah 32: 38 39
