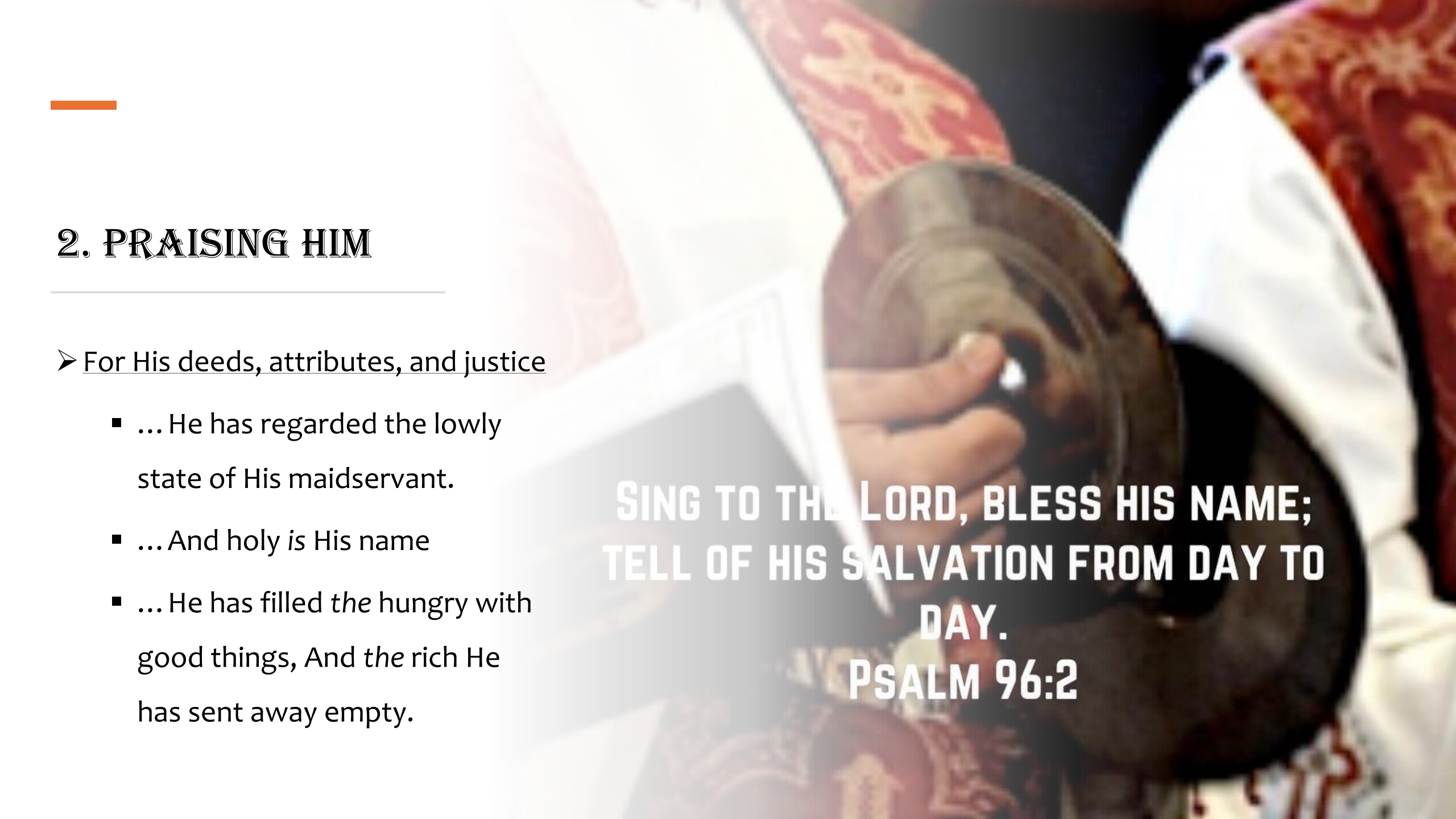

1. OBEYING HIM

- “Behold the maidservant of the Lord! Let it be to me according to your word.” *Luke 1: 38*
- The man born blind obeying and washing his eyes.
- St. Peter obeying the Lord and casting his net in the deep.





2. PRAISING HIM

➤ For His deeds, attributes, and justice

- ... He has regarded the lowly state of His maidservant.
- ... And holy *is* His name
- ... He has filled *the* hungry with good things, And *the* rich He has sent away empty.

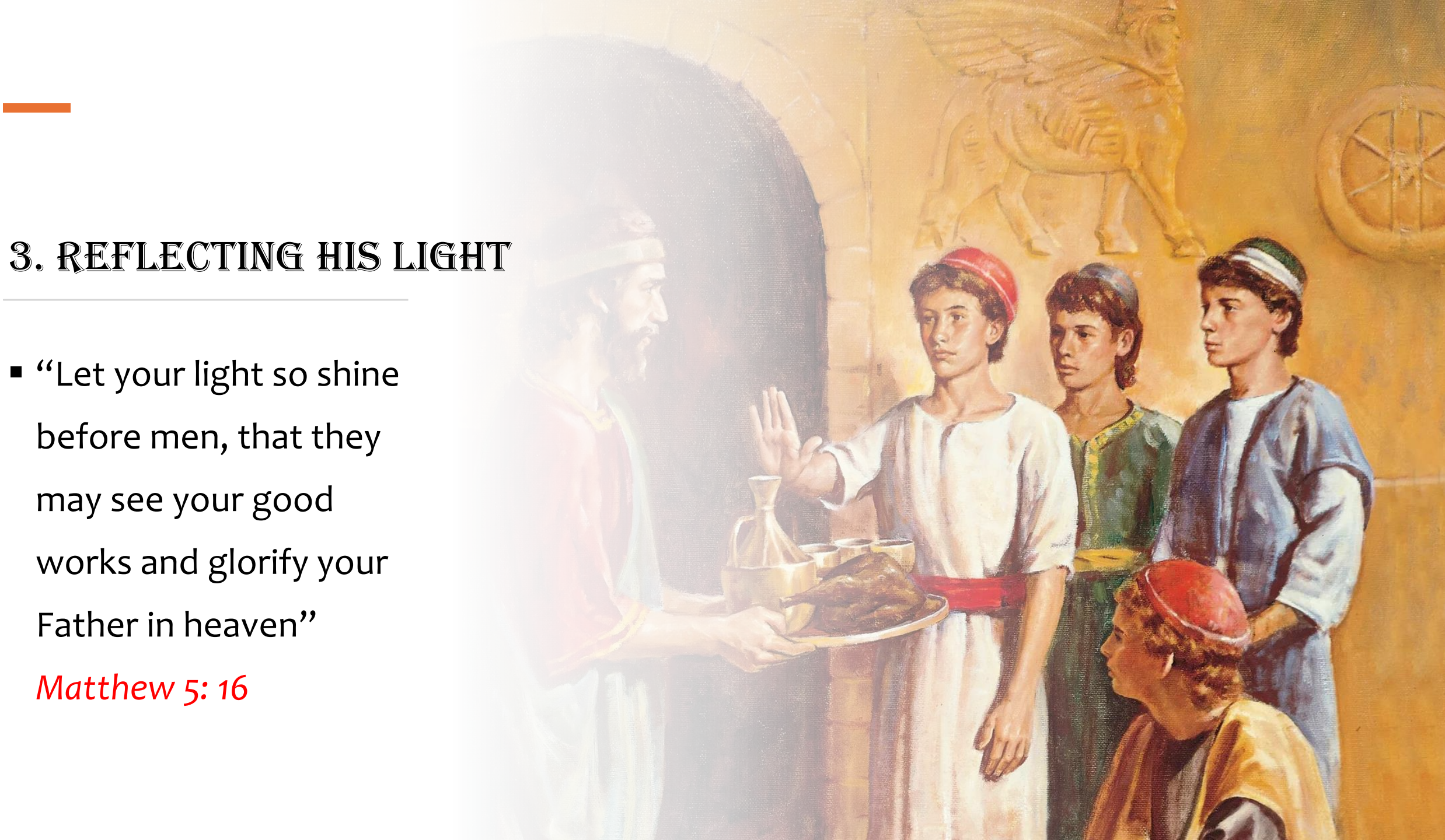
**SING TO THE LORD, BLESS HIS NAME;

5. THE LIFE OF SERVICE

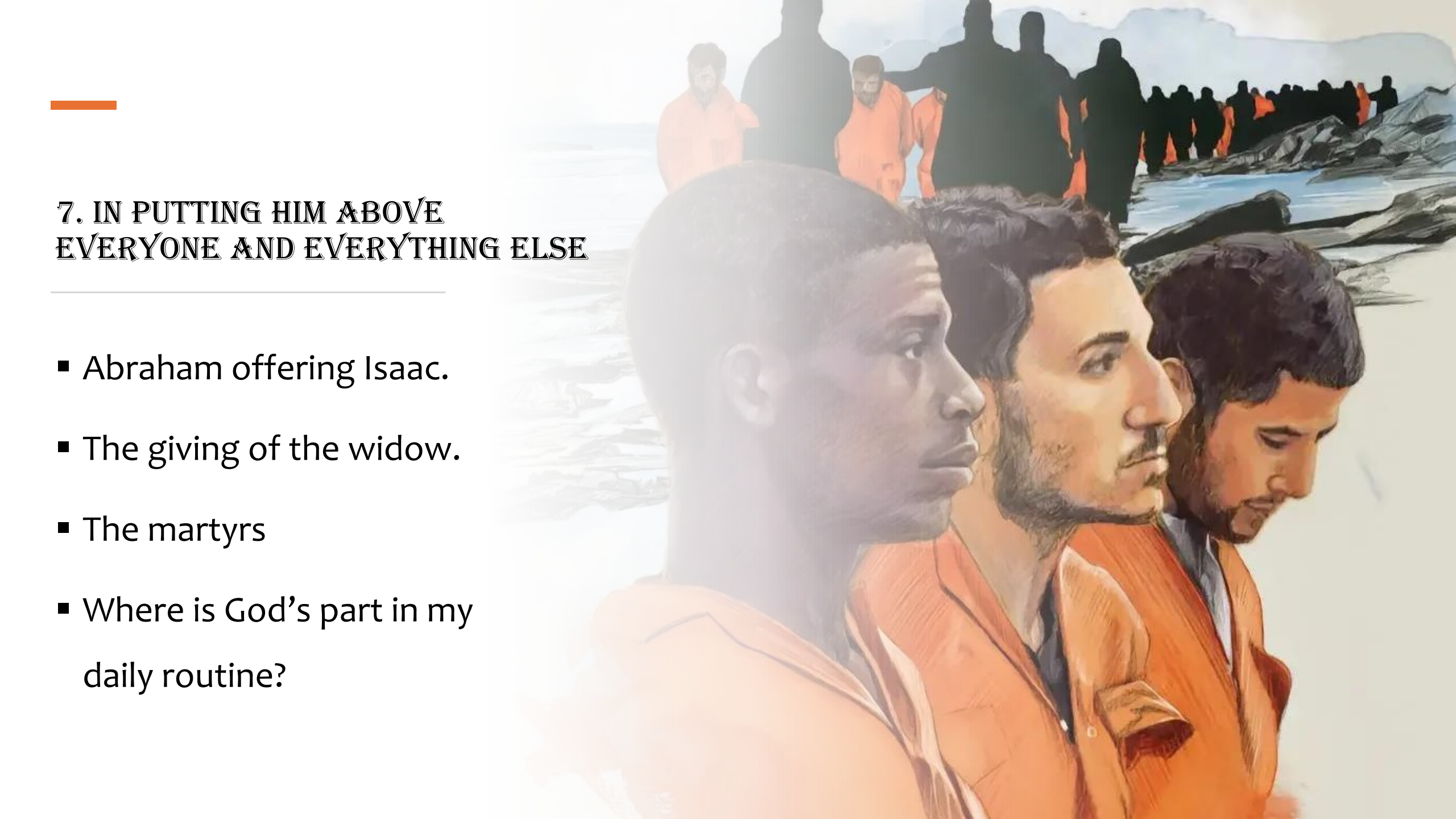
- “I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me.” *Galatians 2:20*
