- 
1. He went out of His way to meet her.
    - He took the initiative.
    - He was not in need... she was.
    - He planned a good time and place to talk with her.






2. He broke barriers with meekness and love.
  - Ethnic, gender, religious, and moral barriers.
  - Winning others by removing walls not building them.



3. He showed humility and sense of need.
  - The Creator asking a sinner to drink.
  - He calmed her anxiety by showing himself in need of her service:  
“Anxiety in the heart of man causes depression, but a good word makes it glad” *Proverbs 12: 25*
  - Humility attracts hearts. People respond to gentleness not superiority.

4. He led the conversation gradually from a common ground to the spiritual.
  - From physical water to living water to eternal life.
  - Learning to move from everyday matters to eternal truths naturally, not abruptly.

5. He awakened her spiritual thirst.
  - Speaking about the spiritual water.
  - “Whoever drinks of this water will thirst again, but whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst” *John 4: 13 - 14*
  - Helping others to recognize their inner emptiness and need before offering the solution.

6. He addressed her sin with compassion and respect.
- “You have well said, ‘I have no husband’” *John 4: 17*
  - He exposed her sin but did not shame her.
  - Correction without love pushes people away.





7. He was patient with her questions and resistance.
- She questioned, debated, and changed topics.
  - The Lord Jesus remained calm and patient.
  - He didn't rush or argue.
- Patience wins hearts.
