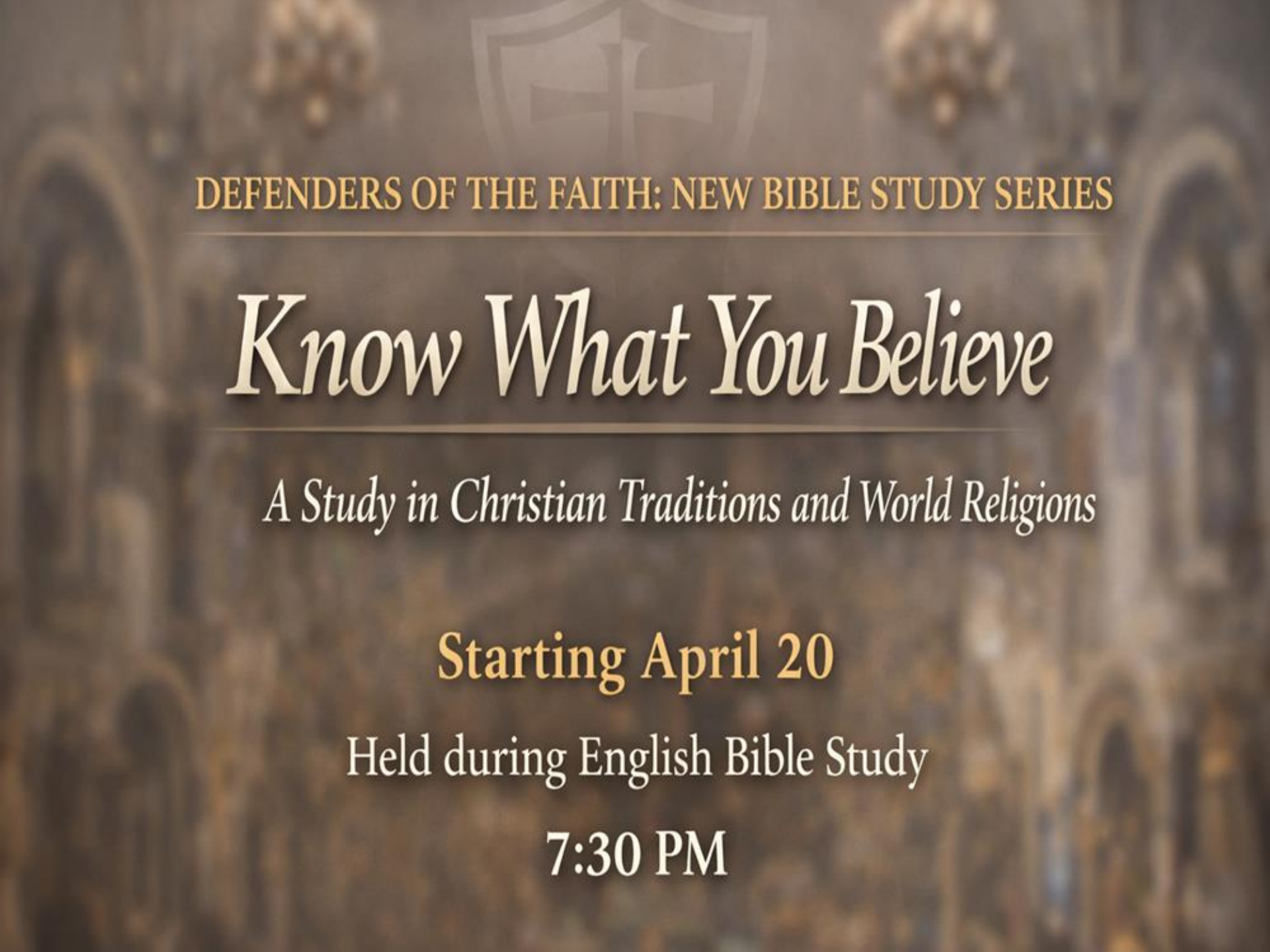

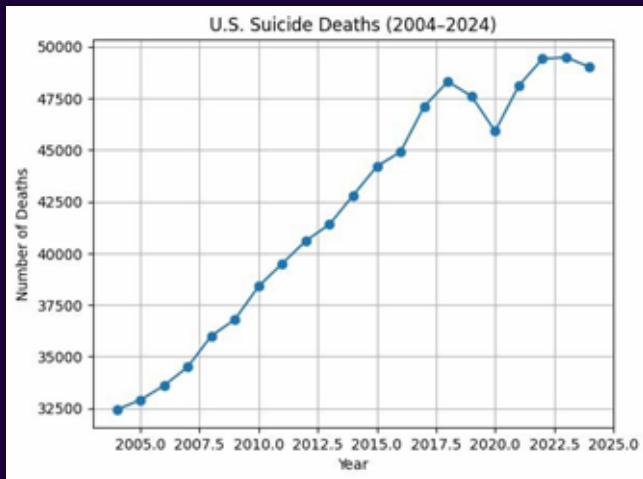


24/7 PRAYER

Church's reverence and respect – guidelines ⁽¹⁾



1. Attending early is a mandate for communion
2. Deacons must arrive by 8:00 am to serve
3. No talking inside the church during the service
4. Cell phones are to be turned off or set on Silent Mode
5. Men and women are to be seated on their respective side
(north side for the men and south side for women)

Church's reverence and respect – guidelines ⁽²⁾



6. Children are not to be permitted to roam inside the church
– no running or talking
7. No eating or drinking inside the sanctuary or the cry room
8. Decent dress code is to be strictly observed – ladies are to
refrain from using lipsticks

Church's reverence and respect – guidelines ⁽³⁾



9. Cooperation with the church ushers is expected from all parishioners.
10. No gathering in the foyer during the service or the announcements
11. Deacons are asked to kindly join the chorus outside

"GOD OF ORDER" POLICY

- No disruptions to Sunday School classes will be tolerated.
- After 2 warnings, the student will continue the class's time in meeting with one of the fathers or the SS Coordinator.
- For other voluntarily activities (Hymns – Bible study – Choir), after 2 warnings, the student will be dismissed.
